NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Rules will be adapted to allow support and coaching during the races.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all sailing dinghies.
- 2.2 The crews of the eligible boats must consist only of junior and/or adult novice sailors with less than two seasons of race experience. However, an additional competent sailor may also be carried on board to provide support, if needed.
- 2.3 RYA Youth Stage 3 or Adult Level 2 (or equivalent) is required as a minimum qualification for all participants. Entries not meeting these criteria will be considered at organising committee's discretion.
- 2.4 Entry form may be requested by emailing piotr.wojtczuk@gmail.com. The entry form will be sent by email together with sailing instructions.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter on the day during registration (see point 4.1) by handing in the entry form together with the required fee. Entry fee is to be paid in cash or by cheque made payable to the Cramond Boat Club.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Double handed	£10.00
Single handed	£5.00

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will be open at the clubhouse from 09:00 to 10:00.
- 4.2 Race briefing will be held at the clubhouse at 09:30.
- 4.3 Dates of racing: Sunday, 12th June 2011.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:30.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be sent on request by email together with the entry form (see point 2.4).

6 PRIZES

6.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

First place Voucher worth £15

Second place Voucher worth £10

Third place Voucher worth £5

6.2 The prizes will be awarded at the clubhouse after sailing.

6.3 Food will be on sale at the clubhouse.

7 DINGHY BOOKING

7.1 CBC members entering the regatta will be able to use club dinghies.

7.2 Due to potential demand on club dinghies at this event, a booking system will be in place.

7.3 Details of the booking procedure will be sent to CBC members after the Notice of Race is published.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
